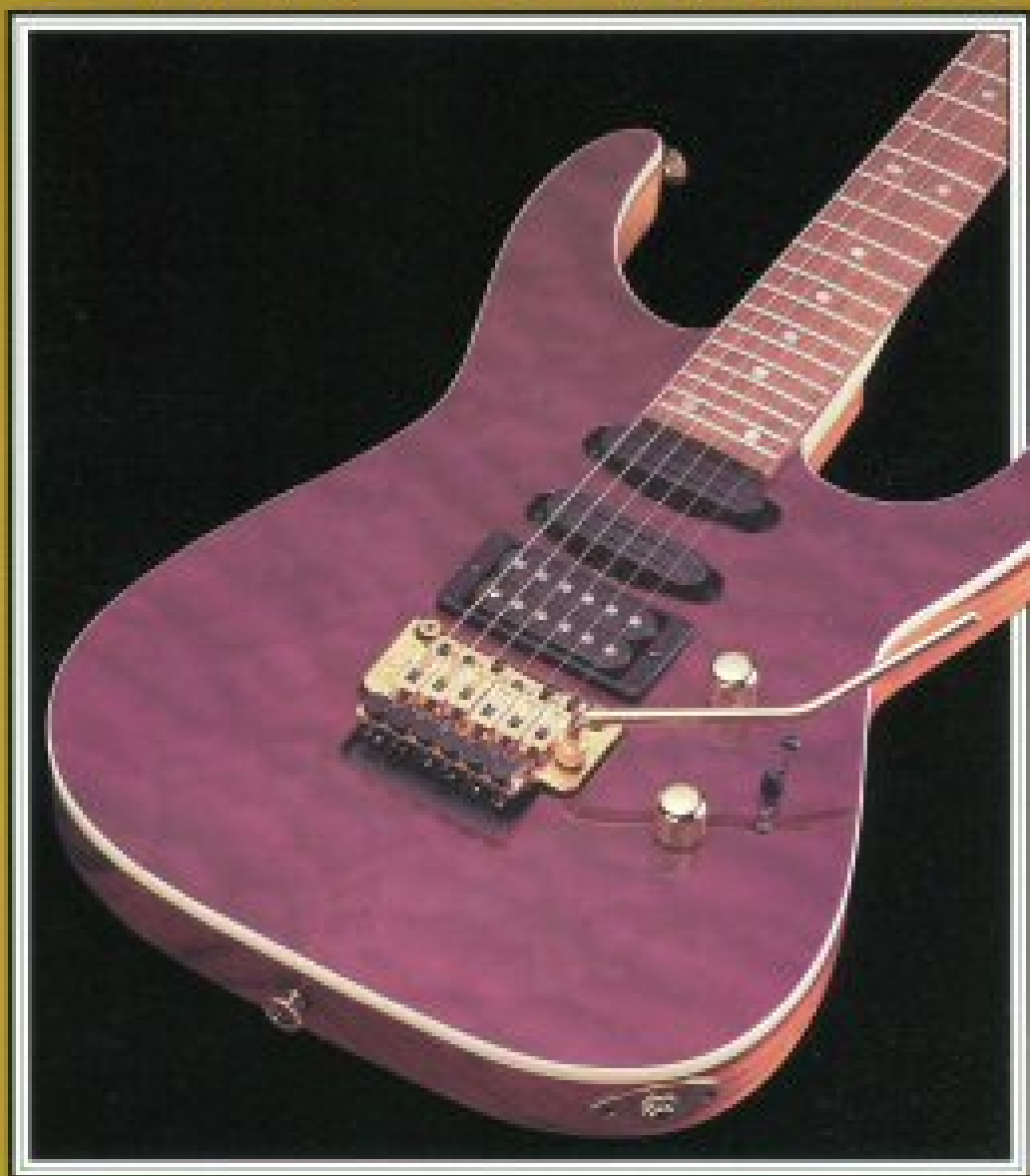

In 1979 the first Charvel guitars were built in a small factory in San Dimas, California. Sought after and played by the best guitarists in the world, the instruments built in that period are now considered collector pieces and virtually impossible to find. However, the spirit of these early instruments lives on in the new San Dimas series. Entirely hand made in the Jackson Custom Shop in Ontario, California, these instruments are built by the same craftsmen who built the first guitars in the late seventies.

With the San Dimas Series, Charvel has gone back to where it all began . . . excellent craftsmanship, beautiful styling and the desire to make the finest instruments possible.

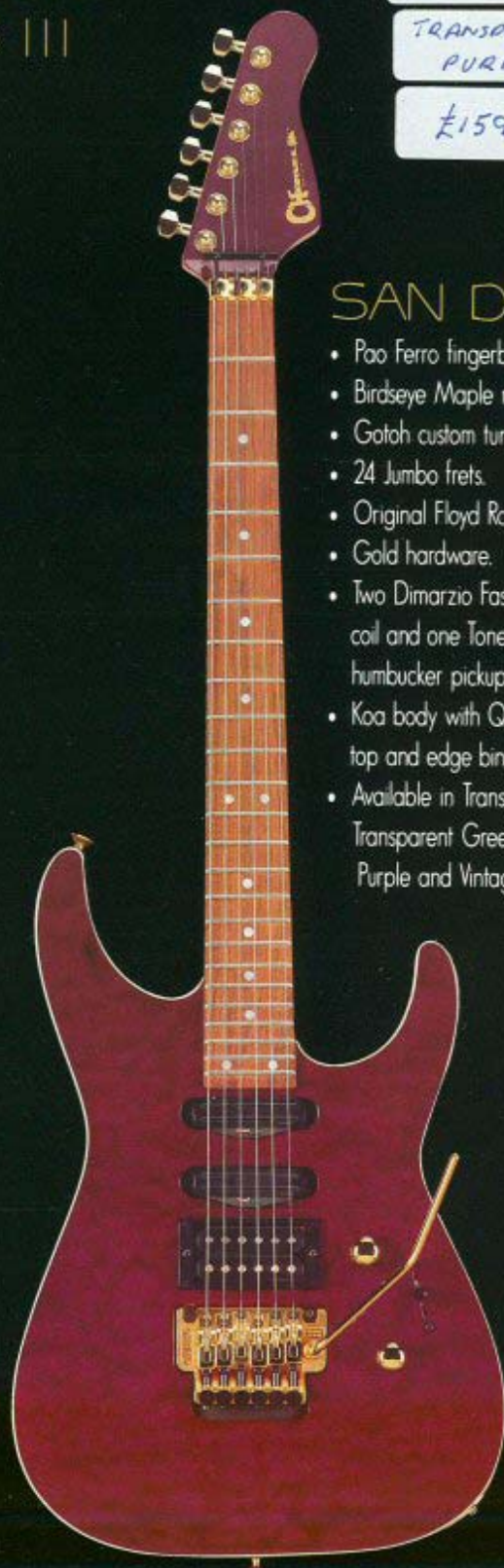

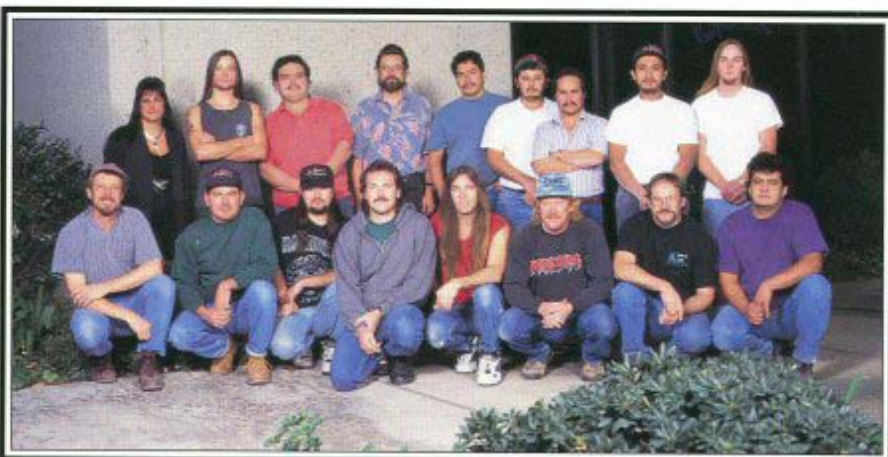
