

# Peavey ReValver Setup Guide

**This is a simple guide how to setup and run Peavey ReValver.**

Start up ReValver and load up a preset off your choice.

To get a god sound and input just play your guitar and press learn button on Input and Output and wait for it to set the best input - output for you.



3. Next press the + sign on the amp and open the tweak page.



4. Now we are to set a god input to the amp, press the two knobs at the upper right (Input Output Shaping)



5. Now set the Nominal input level. (The input voltage slider so you can get the same amount of gain you would get on the real amp, not just volume)

The default setting is made for passiv mic`s. By playing on your guitar and try to set a match for your pick-ups.

If you don't set this you may have a weak or to high signal.

Here is just some examples. (You have to experiment with this to get a god tone according to your play style)

Emg81/85: 1250—1750

Emg 89: 0600-0850

Emg 60: 1300

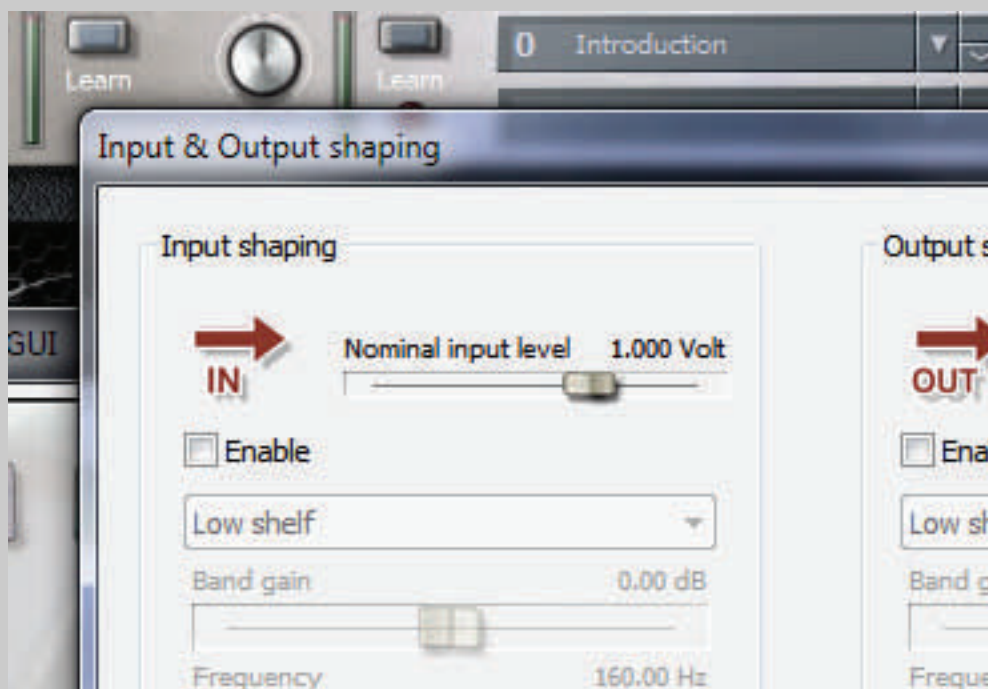
Emg s/sa: 0600-0850

Duncan designed 105 bridge: 2000-2600

Duncan designed 105 neck: 0650-2600

AHB-1 bridge: 2000-2600

AHB-1 neck: 2000-2600
